Points of information

- The children need not wear school uniform but practical clothing is essential. As the weather is so unpredictable, layers of clothing are best e.g. t-shirt, jumper, waterproof coat or jacket.
- As it may be wet underfoot, old trainers or wellingtons are a must. It will, of course, depend on weather conditions on the day.
- If it is a sunny day please put sun cream on your child in the morning.
- The children will all be given a hat to wear so no hats please.
- If your child needs an inhaler or any other medication please see your child's teacher.
- We hope to return to school by 3.15pm (traffic permitting).

Lunch

The children will need a packed lunch on that day so please read the following information carefully:



Nursery children

If your child is in Nursery and has school meals please provide a packed lunch and the cost for dinners that week will be £8.60. If your child is entitled to free school meals a packed lunch will be provided.

Reception children

If your child is in Reception and has a school meal a packed lunch will be provided. If your child usually brings their own packed lunch please send one as usual on the day of the trip.

Children bringing a packed lunch

Please do not send your child's lunch in anything that cannot be disposed of. All their food and drink (not too much please) must be in one plastic bag, marked with their name (no glass bottles please).
